OIL SPILL CLEAN-UP

- The most probable exposure to our community is oil/tar balls or mats
- No specific exposure timeline has been determined for our area
Continuous monitoring is recommended
- The most likely places to begin seeing tar/oil balls or mats:
 - On the beach
 - In the water in areas where floating debris and trash normally collects at high and low tides
- Oil/tar balls spotted on beaches or water:
 - Do not touch, handle or dispose of
 - Contact the County Operations Center at 712-6400 and report it
- Oil affected Wildlife:
 - Do not touch, handle or attempt to clean any affected wildlife
 - Dead or dying sea turtles must be collected and investigated
