1. APPROVING – RESOLUTION NO. 13-10 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA. 2. INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SCHOOL BOARD OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR ROADWAY, TRAFFIC, AND PUBLIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AS IT RELATES TO THE NEW SUNCOAST HIGH SCHOOL.
