

Want to lower your energy costs?

The Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) helps reduce the heating and cooling costs for homeowners by improving the energy efficiency of their homes. This enables low-income families to permanently reduce their energy bills. On average weatherization reduces heating bills by 31 percent and overall energy bills by \$274 per year.

The program is provided through the state Department of Community Affairs and funded annually by the Department of Energy and the Department of Human Services. The program is open to residents in Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River counties.

To qualify, applicants must be homeowners and must meet income requirements. For example, maximum household income for a family of four cannot exceed \$44,100. Priority is given to elderly residents, families with children under age 12 and families with repeatedly high energy bills.
