The Military Trail (State Road 809) milling and resurfacing project, currently under construction from north of Blue Heron Boulevard to south of PGA Boulevard, in the City of Palm Beach Gardens and the City of Riviera Beach, is expected to begin nighttime paving operations in early February 2012.

Maintenance of Traffic:

During this time, two lanes of Military Trail may be closed, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning. The paving is being performed at night to minimize the impacts on residents, businesses, and the motoring public. Paving may last through early April 2012, weather permitting.

Other project-related lane closures may occur daily, 9 a.m. until 4 p.m., throughout the duration of the project. At least one lane on Military Trail will remain open in each direction, and pedestrian access will be maintained on one side of the street at all times.

Scope of Work:

- Milling and resurfacing Military Trail, from north of Blue Heron Boulevard to south of PGA Boulevard
- Signalization and Signage work
- Minor landscaping

This 3.5-mile project began Monday, July 18, 2011, and is expected to be completed late spring 2012. The estimated cost for construction is \$2.9 Million. Work is being performed by Community Asphalt Corporation, with Creative Engineering overseeing the project.
