About Employment at RBPD

Total Compensation Package

Salary – After completing your training, you'll earn a competitive wage* as a Uniformed Road Patrol

Officer. This salary is based on working 12 hour shifts for a total of 2184 hours annually – an average of 42 hours per week.

Equipment and Allowances – Officers are issued standard equipment, which includes a laptop, Glock firearm, Taser, and an AR-15. A Uniform Maintenance Allowance* (paid biweekly) is provided for uniform dry cleaning and washing.

Off Duty Detail – Officers have almost endless opportunities to work private duty and special assignments, on their own time.

Advancement – Opportunity for advancement exists based on your ability. Promotion examinations are conducted periodically. You are allowed to compete for these assignments upon completion of three years of service.



In addition to tactical deployments, the RBPD Mobile Command Center is used in support of various community activities.

Paid Time Off – For the first year of employment, you will receive 12 vacation days, 11 paid holidays and 12 sick days. We also have an Annual Sick and Vacation Buy Back program allowing you to receive pay for

vacation and sick days not taken, up to 80 hours per year.

Tuition Reimbursement/ Education Incentive – Further your education and receive reimbursement for up to 18 credit hours per calendar year. You are also rewarded for the completion of advanced

training courses and for obtaining a degree from an accredited college with an increase of

Minimum Qualifications

- 19 Years of Age
- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- No Felony Convictions
- No Misdemeanor Conviction involving perjury, false statements, moral turpitude, or domestic violence
- Must have a driver's license without suspension in

the past 5 years. No DUI convictions in the past 5 years. See other restrictive driving violations at <u>www.rivierabch.com/PoliceCareers</u>

- Tobacco use prohibited after employment
- Must be honorably discharged from military (if applicable)
- No Marijuana drug use in past 5 years; no cocaine or other illegal narcotic use in past 10 years; no sale of narcotics ever

Training and Examinations

The Riviera Beach Police Department considers both certified and non-certified applicants for employment.

If selected, non-certified applicants will attend Palm Beach State College's Law Enforcement Basic Recruit Training program. This is a sixmonth program that prepares students as entry level law enforcement officers in the State of Florida. Applicants will receive the entry level
