- We have pavilions available at the Municipal Beach and numerous other parks. Most of the pavilions have picnic tables and access to grills.
- This multipurpose skating rink is set up for playing hockey, basketball, or to just roller skate. Want to play hockey? The rink is already lined for that. Have younger kids that want to play basketball? Not only is the rink lined for that, but it also has backboards that can be lowered to accommodate all age and height levels.
- Have your next event at Barracuda Bay Aquatic Complex! Birthday packages are offered during business hours. Packages include your own private covered area, food choices, a picture with Barry the barracuda, and access to the entire water park. Barracuda Bay is also available for private rental after business hours and days not open to the public. We have an interactive pool for the kids, a large competition pool, and two slides for those looking for a thrill.
- Looking for something indoors? We offer three facilities that provide a wide range of planning options. For large events, we have Wells Gym and Tate's Gym. These two facilities have a capacity of 400 people and can be decorated to your taste. 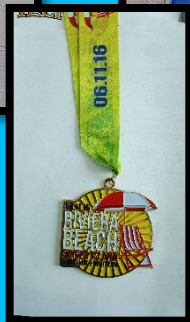
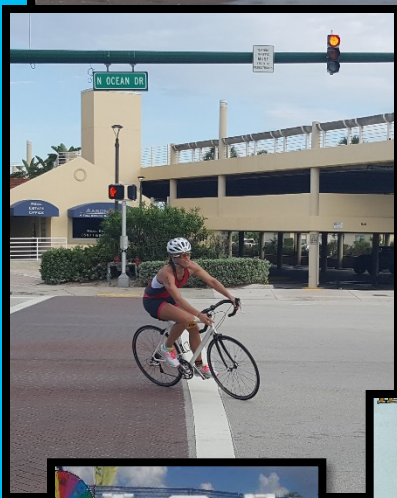
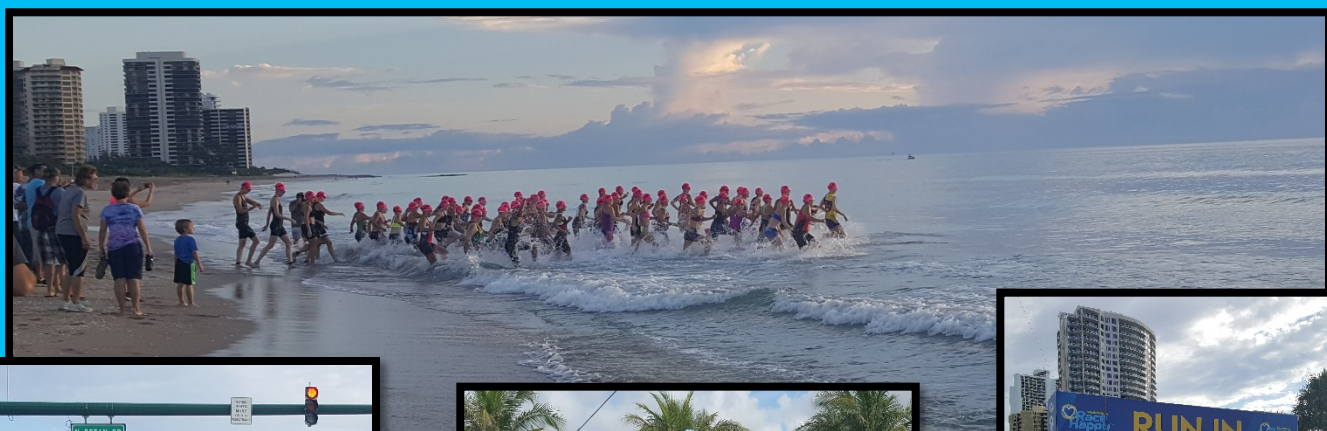
2016 Annual Recreation Month Celebration
