Are you looking for a great location to have your next function? The Parks and Recreation Department has plenty of options for you to choose from.

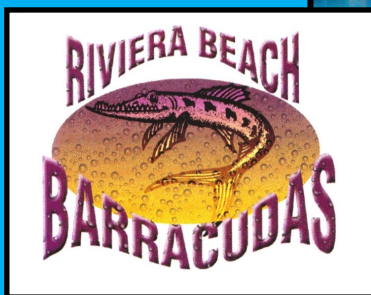
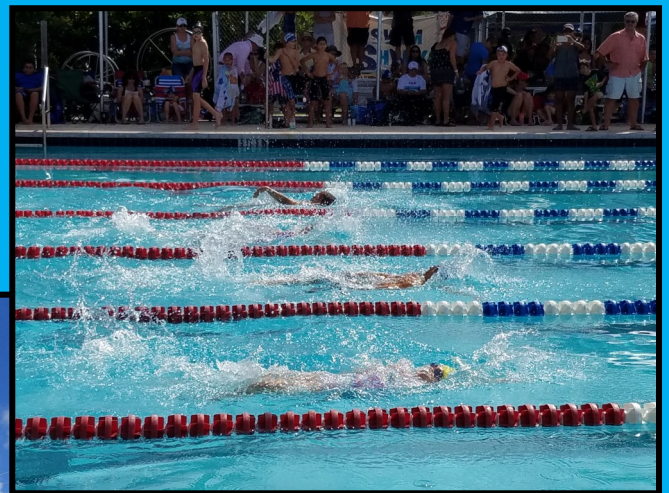
- ❖ The Aqua Spray Area is a safe and unique play structure where water is sprayed from mounted structures and geysers. The Spray Area consist of interactive water features like water cannons, a piano that produce music by stepping on different water holes, and a flute that you can play by plugging holes with your hand. There is also a walk through water shower and numerous ground-level geysers that shoot water up in the air from all different directions.
- ❖ This multipurpose skating rink is set up for playing hockey, basketball, or to just roller skate. Want to play hockey? The rink is already lined for that. Have younger kids that want to play basketball? Not only is the rink lined for that, but it also has backboards that can be lowered to accommodate all age and height levels.
- ❖ We have pavilions available at the Municipal Beach and numerous other parks. Most of the pavilions have picnic tables and access to grills.
- ❖ Have your next event at Barracuda Bay Aquatic Complex! Birthday packages are offered during business hours. Packages include your own private covered area, food choices, a picture with Barry the barracuda, and access to the entire water park.
